## SATELLITE DISH INSTALLATION REQUIREMENTS

## **SECTION 6:**

Paragraph D) Cable TV connections are provided throughout the community.


- 1) External UHF & VHF television antennas and small satellite antennas should be located at the rear of the home as covered in Schedule B.
- 2) Other external communications antennas are not Permitted.

## SCHEDULE B Friendly Village

Dish Antennas for "Direct TV" reception are allowed on homes in the Community. These antennas preferable should be located at the rear quarter of the home away from the street.

Figure A, Dish Assembly, illustrates a typical installation. The Direct TV antenna allowed is 18" X 20 " parabolic. The installation must not exceed the roof peak in height.

Installation must be ON the home. Installation is not allowed on poles, trees, fences, sheds etc. Any dish installed against community guidelines will have to be removed or relocated at the home owner's expense. We do not cut trees to accommodate satellite dishes, nor do we make exceptions to the guidelines due to poor reception.
