WINTER RV/BOAT/TRAILER PARKING POLICY

REMINDER THAT ALL RV'S, CAMPER'S, TRAIL-
ERS AND BOATS IN THE PARK ARE REQUIRED
TO BE PARKED IN THE STORAGE AREA LO-
CATED AT THE END OF ASH DRIVE ON A
FIRST COME FIRST SERVE BASIS, OR OFFSITE.
**ANYONE WITH A SEASONAL VEHICLE WILL
NO LONGER BE ABLE TO PARK THEM ON THE
VACANT LOTS.** STARTING NOVEMBER 1ST,
ALL CAMPER'S, RV'S, BOATS AND TRAILERS
WILL NEED TO BE MOVED TO THE
STORAGE AREA OR STORED OFF SITE.
YOU MAY BRING THEM INTO THE COMMUNI-
TY TO PARK IN YOUR DRIVEWAY OR VACANT
LOT FOR ON A TEMPORARY BASIS LESS THAN
TWO WEEKS AT A TIME TO SERVICE, SET-UP
AND PREP FOR OPEN/CLOSE UP FOR THE
SEASON.
